In an indication of the good score by the winning team both NTP's went to Jake Teague 2 metres on the 2<sup>nd</sup> /11<sup>th</sup> and Mac Dawson 1.63 metres on the 8<sup>th</sup> /17<sup>th</sup>.

In the ladies 18 Hole Stableford, four ladies had an enjoyable day with some good golf produced especially by winner Julie Leckie who had 40 points. Wendy Clift played solidly for 36 points which gained her a ball.

Last Sunday the Masters Pennant team travelled to Tanilba Bay and started their season with a narrow loss to the home side by 4 ½ to 3.
