

SCONE GOLF REPORT for April 30, 2015

“Heavy course for golfers”

Last Saturday at Scone the men golfers played an 18 Hole Stableford on a heavy course. The best score of the day was by Scott Lye who had 38 points to win C Grade. A Grade was closely contested with Derek Field being the winner on a countback from Mick Reynolds. Geoff Barton won B Grade on 33 but missed out on a ball on a countback, but he did win the NTP on the 2nd /11th with a shot to 1.02 metres. The NTP on the 8th / 17th was won by Charlie Manning at 7.0 metres. Ball winners were Scott Lye 38, Derek Field 37, Mick Reynolds 37, Charlie Manning 36, Cliff Cooper 35, Clayton Rogers 35, George Campbell 34, Sean Constable 34, Graham White 34, Les Cottam 33, Glen Tarrant 33, David Spies 33 c/b. In the ladies 18 Hole Stableford Lyn Banks had 36 points to be the winner narrowly from Julie Leckie on 35, with both winning balls.

This Saturday May 2 the Monthly Mug Stroke / Stableford will be held and the following week an 18 Hole Stableford for the Clayton Rogers Trophy will be played. A reminder that the first round of the Kevans Knockout must be played by May 9.
