

## SCONE GOLF REPORT for July 23, 2015

### “ Winter golf ”

Last Thursday the Scone lady golfers started off in fine conditions but this quickly changed after a few holes. After a drenching, some sunshine, intermittent showers and windy conditions prevailed, and to top it off the temperature reached a maximum of 10 degrees. Most players departed the course with the initial downpour. Jo Brown was amongst the stayers and won with 33 points, whilst Ruth Wallace pipped Lyn Banks on a countback for runner on 30 points. Ruth also won the NTP on the 2<sup>nd</sup> /11<sup>th</sup>. In the Peter and Marg Marshall singles knockout Narelle Rutter defeated Judy Carmody, Julie Leckie defeated Sheena Carter and Jo Brown received a forfeit from June Jukes.

Today Thursday July 23, the Foursomes Championships will be played over 27 holes for scratch and nett trophies. Next Thursday the event is an 18 Hole Stableford 4BBB Multiplier for the Elizabeth Kevans and Steph McGuirk Trophy.

Last Saturday July 18, an 18 Hole Individual and 2B Worst Ball Stableford for the James and Justin Smart Trophy was played. This is an interesting concept requiring both players to play well. The course again had little run after the rain during the week making scoring difficult. The winners were Clayton Rogers and Mick Alsleben on 28 points and the runners up were David Spies and Jake Teague on 26 points. The Bradmans prize went to Graham White and Mick Reynolds. The individual winner was Mark Hayes, who is on a bit of a roll at the moment, having 38 points.

The NTP's were won by Mick Reynolds 3.52 metres on the 2<sup>nd</sup> /11<sup>th</sup>, and by Greg Parkinson 2.3 metres on the 8<sup>th</sup> /17<sup>th</sup>. The ball winners were Mark Hayes 38, Lindsay Hodge 37, Noel Leckie 37, Greg Parkinson 36, Paul Smart 35, David Spies 34, Brad Hockley 34, Mick Alsleben 34, Jeff Harrington 33, Joel Woods 32, Geoff Barton 32, Jake Teague 32, Clayton Rogers 31, James Archibald 31, Glen Tarrant 31 and Brenan Reeves 30 on a countback.

In the ladies 18 Hole Stableford Kerry McLennan had 34 points to be the winner.

Next Saturday July 25, an 18 Hole Stableford for the G & E Wilkinson Trophy will be played. It is the also the second round of the President's Trophy.
