

SCONE GOLF REPORT for June 11, 2015

“Fine days for golf”

After a frosty start last Thursday the Scone lady golfers enjoyed a lovely day for golf. However, the course played long due to the recent rain and the scores reflected such. Narelle Rutter had the best round of the day to be the winner of the 18 Hole Stroke and fourth Monthly Medal and GNSW Medal. Her 78 nett won the Melanie's Jewellers Trophy, whilst June Jukes was runner up on 79 nett. Kathy Robinson had the least putts on 28. Noreen Marshall chipped in on the second to win the birdie box of three balls and June Jukes also had a gobbler for a birdie on the 16th. No player managed a shot onto the 8th /17th for the NTP although there were a few near misses. Ball winners were Gael Holland 79, Lyn Banks 82, Marie Murray 82, Trish Dunnill 84, Kathy Robinson 84 and Judy Carmody 86.

Last week some Scone ladies played in the Hunter River District Championships at Cypress Lakes and in the foursomes at Hunter Valley Golf Club. Jo Brown and Lyn Banks were best performed to finish third overall and third in Division One nett in the foursomes. Meanwhile, some others supported the North Northwest District in their tournament at Narrabri. Wendy Clift obviously liked the course as she won the Division 2 nett on day one, was runner up in the scratch in Division 2 after the two days, and took out the Veterans event. Next Wednesday a contingent will support the Muswellbrook Ladies Open.

Today Thursday June 11, the ladies will play the third round of stableford for the Sue and Alan Watts Trophy. Next week the event is an 18 Hole Par and the third round of the Ruth Wallace Trophy with the daily trophy donor Kathy Robinson.

Last Saturday in perfect conditions, a good field turned out for the men's 18 Hole Stroke / Stableford for the Monthly Mug. Clayton Rogers won the Mug with a solid 72 nett and the grade winners were: A Grade, Jeff Harrington 33 points, B Grade Brad Hockley 36 points and C Grade Jeremy White 33 points. Glen Tarrant, 4.7metres, won the NTP on the 2nd /11th and Alan Wood won 8th /17th with 5.47metres. The ball winners were Brad Hockley 36, Clayton Rogers 36, Tony O'Neill 34, Alan Wood 33, Jeff Harrington 33 Campbell Leckie 33, Jeremy White 33, Glen Tarrant 33, John Roe 32, Geoff Barton 32, Noel Leckie 32 and Garry Taylor 31 on a countback.

On Saturday June 13, the men will play an 18 Hole Individual and 2B Stableford for the Liz and Paul Smart Trophy. It will also be Round 1 of the Captain's Trophy.

On Sunday the fifth round of the Masters Pennant will be played with the men travelling to Muree. Other players will contest the HRDGA Ambrose Pairs Championship at Muswellbrook.

Next Saturday an 18 Hole Stableford for the Scott Reid Trophy will be played and it is also Round 1 of the R. J. Lowrie Cup. Round 3 matches in the Kevans Knockout need to be played by June 27. Some dates to keep free for coming events are Sunday June 28 for the 27 Hole Men's Foursomes Championships, played in three grades. On Sunday July 5 the Mixed Foursomes Championship will be played over 18 holes.
