

SCONE GOLF REPORT for June 18, 2015

“Great score at golf”

Scone golfers last Saturday played an 18 Hole Individual and 2B Stableford for the Liz and Paul Smart Trophy and it was Round 1 of the Captain's Trophy. Fine conditions and a well prepared course allowed some good scores for the players, and a couple will no doubt have handicap adjustments before their next outing.

The winners were Rod Vaughan and Lindsay Hodge with a huge 48 points, Lindsay contributing the bulk of these as he had 45 individually! Grade winners were Jeff Harrington in A Grade with 37 points, George Davidson likewise in B Grade and C Grade to Lindsay Hodge.

The NTP's were won by Jeff Harrington 2.07 metres on the 2nd /11th, and by Kevin Thompson 3.6 metres on the 8th /17th. Balls went to Lindsay Hodge 45, Tony Bowd 40, Kevin Thompson 38, Jeff Harrington 37, John Roe, Gordon Halliday and Mark Hayes 36, Clayton Rogers and David Walters 35, Simon Groom and Phil McGuirk 34, Adrian Fuller, Col Solway and Alan Wood all on 33.

Last Sunday in the fifth round of the Masters Pennant Scone travelled to Muree and found the locals too strong on their home course. The divisional leaders didn't lose a match and Scone now only have a trip to Nelson Bay next Sunday to conclude the season.

This Saturday June 20 an 18 Hole Stableford for the Scott Reid Trophy will be played and it will also be Round 1 of the R. J. Lowrie Cup. The following Saturday an 18 Hole Stableford for the Tony Bowd and Mark Hayes Trophy will be played.

Players in the Kevans Knockout need to arrange their third round matches by June 27. Nomination sheets are up for the 27 Hole Men's Foursomes Championships on Sunday June 28, and for the 18 Hole Mixed Foursomes on Sunday July 5 so start getting your partners organised.

Last Thursday the ladies played an 18 Hole Stableford on a nicely presented course. The wind got up during the morning making play more difficult. The winner was Lyn Banks who had 34 points to edge out runner up Trish Dunnill on a countback. The NTP 2nd /11th was won by Trish in Division 1 and Kathy Robinson and Sarah Brooks in the other two divisions. Balls went to June Jukes and Kathy Robinson 33, Marie Murray 31, Jo Brown and Noreen Marshall on 28.

Today, June 18, the ladies will play an 18 Hole Par for the Kathy Robinson Trophy and it is the final round of the Ruth Wallace Trophy. Next Thursday June 25 will be the start of the Peter and Marg Marshall singles Knockout with an 18 Hole Stableford for those not involved in the knockout.
