“Adam Moore wins Kevans Knockout”

An 18 Hole Stableford for the Noel Leckie and James Archibald Trophy was played with the overall winner being Col Solway with 37 points. Further prizes went to Phil McGuirk 36, Warren Styles 35 and Scott Reid also on 35. The ball winners were the above players and S. Bourke, Andy Phelps 35, Derek Field, John Roe, Adam Moore, Oscar Field 34, Charlie Manning, Clayton Rogers, David Druce 33 and Kevin Thompson 31.

The NTP's were won by Oscar Field on the 2nd /11th at 1.89 metres and on the 8th / 17th by Jeff Harrington 2.52 metres.

The final of the Kevans Knockout was played between Adam Moore and Steve Morse. Adam was a convincing winner 6 & 5, and won the much sought after event for the first time.

This Saturday November 21, an 18 Hole Stableford will be played for the George Betts Trophy, and on November 28 the Joel Woods and Graham White Trophy will also be a stableford.
