

## SCONE GOLF REPORT for November 26, 2015

### **“Adam Moore wins Kevans Knockout”**

Last Saturday the Scone golfers played an 18 Hole Stableford for the George Betts Trophy. Gordon Halliday was the A Grade winner with 38 points whilst George Davidson had the best score of the day with 39 points to win B Grade. Visitor Robert Ryan won C Grade with 37 points. Two jackpots went off on the 2<sup>nd</sup> / 11<sup>th</sup> with both Jeff Harrington and Warren Styles getting six balls, and Jeff one extra for the NTP at 0.86 metres, 3 centimetres closer than Warren. Not to worry, Warren won the 8th / 17<sup>th</sup> with 2.2 metres.

The ball winners were: George Davidson 39, Gordon Halliday 38, Robert Ryan 37, Tony O'Neill, Warren Styles, Col Solway 36, Jeff Harrington, John Murray 34, Ross Banks, Gary Leake 33, Mark Hayes and John Kevans 32.

Previously the final of the Kevans Knockout was played between Adam Moore and Steve Morse. Adam was a convincing winner 6 & 5, and won the much sought after event for the first time.

On Saturday November 14 the course was in a heavy condition after overnight rain. An 18 Hole Stableford for the Noel Leckie and James Archibald Trophy was played with the overall winner being Col Solway with 37 points. Further prizes went to Phil McGuirk 36, Warren Styles 35 and Scott Reid also on 35. The ball winners were the above players and S. The NTP's were won by Oscar Field on the 2<sup>nd</sup> / 11<sup>th</sup> at 1.89 metres and on the 8th / 17<sup>th</sup> by Jeff Harrington 2.52 metres.

This Saturday November 28, the Joel Woods and Graham White Trophy will be played for with an 18 Hole Stableford. On Saturday December 5 a Stroke / Stableford for the Monthly Mug will be held. The draw for the Summer Knockout is displayed on the noticeboard with first round matches needing to be played by December 19.

The lady golfers have concluded their 18 hole season on Thursdays. The last event was won by Narelle Rutter with 35 points on a countback from Jo Brown, with Kathy Robinson winning the NTP on the 2<sup>nd</sup> / 11<sup>th</sup>. Today November 26, the 9 hole stableford will commence starting with the front 9. Next Thursday the event will be played on the back 9 for the Asser House Trophy. For those wishing to continue some 18 hole golf there is still the option of a playing on Saturday.
